



Eisenhower matrix

Tool to categorize tasks into four quadrants based on urgency and importance to prioritize

Eat-the-frog method

Technique to focus on completing the most important task first to build momentum for the day


Anchoring method

Setting a benchmark or starting point to measure progress and motivate towards a goal

Focus approach

Productivity method to minimize distractions and dedicate time to high-priority tasks




Pyramid Principle

Method of organizing information by arranging it in a clear and concise hierarchy, starting with the most important information and building on it

MECE principle

Method for organizing and presenting information in a clear, concise, and non-overlapping manner – often used in business contexts



Three phases of a good story

A good story goes through three phases: "Normal" sets the context, "Explosion" introduces conflict and change, and "New Normal" shows the resolution

Four components of a good story

Four components allow listeners to connect with the story: identification characters, authentic emotions, significant moments, and specific details
